Thank you for attending the Planet Expo and Conference, held as part of the Planet Budapest event and organised by the Blue Planet Climate Protection Foundation.

Please find below detailed visitor information regarding access to the event venue, the Hungarian Railway Museum.

Access to the Hungarian Railway Museum

By public transport from central Budapest

- Metro line M4 to Keleti Railway Station → Bus 30 or 30A from Baross tér towards Káposztásmegyer → alight at Rokolya utca → approx. 5–7 minutes on foot.
- Metro line M3 to Göncz Árpád városközpont → Bus 120 towards Újpest-központ → alight at Reitter Ferenc utca → approx. 6–8 minutes on foot.
- Metro line M3 to Lehel tér → Tram 14 towards Káposztásmegyer → alight at Rokolya utca → approx. 5–7 minutes on foot.

By Car

The venue can be accessed from Tatai út in Budapest's 14th district. On-site parking is available within the Hungarian Railway Museum in the designated visitor parking areas marked P1 / P2.



Access to the Conference Dome

The Planet Expo and Conference are part of the Planet Budapest experience program.



Upon entering the Hungarian Railway Museum, all conference attendees are required to collect a wristband, regardless of whether they enter via the main entrance or Entrance No. 2.

Please proceed to the entrance point to receive your wristband, which is required for access to the museum grounds.

Once inside, follow the signage to the Planet Main Entrance, which also serves as the entrance to the Gigadome.

Inside the Gigadome, please follow the Expo Corridor leading to the Expo reception area, where conference registration will take place.

Restrooms and the Expo cloakroom are located along the connecting corridor.

Please allow additional time for arrival, as access from the parking area to the conference venue takes approximately 10–15 minutes.

Please note that due to the heritage-listed nature of the Hungarian Railway Museum, ground surfaces may be uneven in certain areas. Cobblestone paths and other surfaces that may affect mobility are present along the route.
